Law enforcers to go on strike against Jamaat pickets

Law enforcement agencies have said that they will be more vigilant and stricter to those trying to vandalise public properties or carry out acts of sabotage during Bangladesh Jamaat-e-Islami's nationwide dawn-to-dusk shutdown today.

The party is observing the hartal protesting the arrest and remand of nine of its top leaders and demanding their immediate release.

However, police were alert across the country, including Dhaka, yesterday to prevent sabotages ahead of the strike.

Rapid Action Battalion (RAB) also conducted

searches at check-posts at different places and interventions in the capital yesterday evening.

On Monday, police detectives had arrested top Jamaat leaders, including Ameer Maqbul Ahmmed, Nayeb-e-ameer Mia Ghousia Parwar, Secretary General Shafiqur Rahman and party's Chittagong city president Ameer Mawlana Shahjahan from a house in Uttara.

On Tuesday, Jamaat held countrywide demonstrations while the leaders were remanded. Late in the evening, Jamaat issued a statement announcing shutdown for today.
